4. Bidders should submit filled in part A, as well as any other additional information like details of previous supply made to sister Transport Corporations, in their Bid to be submitted.
5. They should submit their bid as per S.No. 3, Section III of Part B in the prescribed envelope given along with this Bid Documents.
6. The bidder before filling Part 'A' of this document should carefully go through Part 'B' and Part 'C' and offer its bid.
7. In case, the bidder had not furnished any information, MTC reserves the right to presume that particular addition /deletion to basic rate is not applicable to the bid or to presume any value considered by MTC as justifiable.

2. SIGNING OF THE BID

- 2.1) The bid shall clearly typed or written in legible ink and shall be signed by the bidder or persons duly authorized to bind the bidder to the contract.
- 2.2) All pages of the bid, except for un amended printed literatures, shall be initiated by the persons signing the bid.
- 2.3) The bid shall contain no inter lineation erasures or overwriting except as necessary to correct errors made by the bidder, in which case all corrections shall be initiated by the persons signing the bid.

3.4) On the envelope containing the bid, it should be written "Bid-not to be opened tillhours on....." (The Bidder may note that the Bid due date and time shall be duly filled and written on the envelope)

4. RECEIPT OF BIDS:

4.1) Bids will not be received after the hour and date fixed as the dead line for submission of bids Telegraphic bids including telex, cable or facsimile bids will not be accepted under any circumstances.

4.2) MTC will not take any responsibility for any delay including the postal delay.

4.3) Bids received by post, if rejected will not be returned to the bidders.

4.4) Bids opened before the due date and time for opening, due to the absence of any information on the envelope containing the bid, as stipulated in clause 3.3 above, will be rejected.

5. OPENING OF BIDS:

5.1) Bids received and accepted will be opened at the prescribed time as furnished in Section I at the Corporate Office, Metropolitan Transport Corporation (Chennai) Limited, Pallavan Salai, Chennai 600 002.

5.2) Only one representation of the bidder, with the bidder's authorization letter will be allowed to attend the bid opening.

5.3) In the event of the specified last date for submission of bids, being declared a holiday for MTC, the bids will be received up to the

appointed time on the next working day and will be opened at the appointed time on the same day.

- 5.4) The bidders' names, bid prices, discounts, EMD value and such relevant details of the bids as MTC at its discretion, may consider appropriate will be announced on the opening of each bid.

6. EVALUATION OF BIDS:

- 6.1) Preliminary examination and rejection

A Bid will be rejected, if

- i) The bidder withdraws its bid before opening.
- ii) Any information to be superscribed on the envelope containing the bid is not found, which will lead to opening of the bid prior to dead line for opening of bids.
- iii) The bid is written in languages other than English and Tamil.
- iv) The bid is not accompanied by EMD to the required amount / or not accompanied by documentary evidence to claim exemption from remittance of EMD.
(The bidder may please note that more statement as 'SSI/MSME Unit ' will not be enough)
- v) MTC receive information, about 'Blacklisting' of the bidder from (State and Central Government, Government undertakings, ASRTU, CIRT, IRT and STUs).

- 6.2) MTC, at its discretion, may reject a bid or may consider for further evaluation with due negative weightage if,

- i) There is any deviation from or objection or reservation to any provision of this bid documents including Terms and Conditions, and the Contract Agreement with the General and Special Conditions of contract, which in the opinion of MTC, is a critical provision or a substantial deviation.

- 6.3) For the proposes of the provision of clause 6.2 above, MTC may consider, in General, the following provisions as critical provisions:

- i) Section I
- ii) Clauses 1.2 of Section III
- iii) Clauses 1.1 2.3, 2.5, 2.6, 5.2, 6.1, 7.2, 8.1, and 8.4 of Section IV
- iv) Section V, and Annexure I

- 6.4) MTC reserves the right to accept or reject any bid or all bids without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- 6.5) In case of absence of any information or response to any provision of Bid documents. MTC reserves the right to presume that the bidder has accepted the provision. In case of absence of any information or data required for evaluation of the bid, bid price and supply schedule, MTC reserves the right (i) to adopt any value for the data, which it consider reasonable, and evaluate the bid, or (ii) to reject the bid or (iii) seek the data or information from the bidder, which the bidder shall oblige to furnish.
- 6.6) All the bids which has not been rejected due to the provisions in clauses 6.1 to 6.5 above, will be grouped under different classifications as per provision of Clause (3) of Section IV.
- 6.7) Bid prices would be evaluated on the following basis.

The processing and evaluation of tenders will be followed in strict adherence to the provisions of the Tamilnadu Transparency in Tender Act and Rules.

In case of ex-works if the Transportation cost is not quoted, in the Commercial Bid, it will be calculated for the purpose of evaluation at the following rates.

However, MTC reserves the right to adopt any rate, within the ranges mentioned above, which MTC considers reasonable for a particular origin and the bidder may note that the above rates are only for general guidelines and this rate does not include the allowance for interstate entry taxes and similar levies.

- 6.8) Whenever there is discrepancy between the total price, calculated based on unit rate quoted and the quantity and (ii) the total price quoted to the bid, the total price calculated

based on unit rate will only be considered. Similarly, any amount written in words will prevail over the amount written numerically.

6.9) Bids will, then be compared and successful bidder(s) will be decided based on

i) 'Evaluated Price (without taxes) (ii) Net payment evaluated to be made (iii) Supply and delivery schedule quoted in the bid (iv) Classification of the bidder (v) Bid validity, (vi) Past experience about the bidder and the quality of the bid item (vii) Production capacity (viii) Warranty / Guarantee given (ix) Test reports (x) Compliance to specification provisions (xi) Compliance to Bid documents provisions and (xii) Inspection report samples submitted.

6.10) MTC reserves the right to award the contract/issue purchase order to one or more bidders, enhance/reduce the quantity given in the Tender Schedule and allot quantity / delivery period to each bidder at its discretion for each bid item dealt separately.

6.11) MTC also reserves the right to enhance / reduce the quantity, alter the delivery schedule and to cancel the Contract / Purchase Order so awarded as given in 6.10 above.

7) AWARD OF CONTRACT:

7.1) MTC will issue a purchase order to each bidder so selected, furnishing the Bid rate, Total rate, quantity to be supplied against specified time periods, Destination etc.

7.2) Within seven days of receipt of the purchase order, the successful bidder shall arrange to sign the contract Agreement as per the format furnished in the bid documents and as approved by MTC and also shall arrange to remit a 'Security Deposit'.

7.3) Agreement shall be executed on Non-judicial stamp paper of value not less than Rs.20/-.

7.4) MTC will issue a purchase order to the successful Bidder. No amendment will be entertained in the firm name in due course of completion of order. The supply of the entire quantity as per P.O will be done by the firm against which purchase order issued.

8) SECURITY DEPOSIT:

- 8.1) The successful bidder shall remit a 'Security Deposit' in the form of a Demand Draft or Bank Guarantee in favour of Metropolitan Transport Corporation (Chennai) Limited, Chennai - 600 002, 'Payable at Chennai, obtained from any Nationalised Bank, for an amount equal to 2% of the total contract price to be ordered or a Bank Guarantee for an amount of 2% of the contract value, valid for the entire contract period. It will be refunded to the firm subject to the completion of purchase order satisfactorily in all respects by the firm.
- 8.2) No interest will be paid on Security Deposit.
- 8.3) Those firms / Units eligible for exemption from remittance of EMD, will also be eligible for exemption from remittance of Security Deposit. However, the successful bidder, in case, shall furnish an undertaking on Non-judicial stamp paper of value not less than Rs.40/- (Rupees forty only), agreeing to pay MTC, an amount equivalent to 2% of the contract price in the event of non-fulfillment or breach of contract.
- 8.4) If the successful bidder fails to remit the Security Deposit or the undertaking if applicable as said above, otherwise the bidder's EMD shall be forfeited and the award of contract to such a bidder will be withdrawn.

9) OTHERS:

- 9.1) Cost of preparation and submission of the bid, and cost of preparation of the Contract Agreement document will be borne by the bidder. In case of tender documents downloaded, there is no cost.

SECTION - IV

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF BIDDING

1. BID VALIDITY:

- 1.1 Bids shall be kept valid for the period of Bid validity as specified in Technical Bid and if any other validity is quoted by the firm in the tender document the decision of MTC will be the final.

2. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD):

- 2.1 The bidder, AS PART OF ITS BID shall remit Earnest Money Deposit (EMD), in the form of Demand Draft obtained from any Nationalised Bank, in favour of Metropolitan Transport Corporation (Chennai) Limited, Chennai - 600 002, payable at Chennai, for an amount as furnished in Annexure **I**.
- 2.2 Any bid not accompanied with the demand draft towards EMD, for the required amount, will be rejected, unless eligible for exemption.
- 2.3 EMD will be forfeited, if the bidder withdrew its bid after opening of the bids.
- 2.4 EMD remitted will be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders by cheque, after finalisation of the tender.
- 2.5 EMD will be forfeited, if the successful bidder fails to sign the contract agreement and to furnish the security deposit, within the stipulated period.
- 2.6 No interest will be paid on EMD
- 2.7 EMD will be refunded to the successful bidder(s) after signing the contract Agreement and remitting the prescribed security deposit.
- 2.8 Those bidders, registered as SSI/MSME units, by Government of Tamilnadu, Government of India, Government Department, Undertakings, Corporations owned by Government of Tamilnadu are eligible for exemption from remittance of EMD. Those bidders, who claim exemption from remittance of EMD, shall furnish an undertaking on non-judicial stamp paper of value not less than Rs.40/- (Rupees forty only) to the effect that the bidder agrees to pay an amount equal to the value of EMD, in the event of breach of the terms and conditions of its bid documents.

3. CLASSIFICATION OF THE BIDDER:

- 3.1 The bidders shall be grouped for the purpose of this bid to the following classification:
- i) Original Equipment Manufacturers and suppliers to vehicle Manufacturers.
 - ii) DGS & D RATE Contract holders
 - iii) Manufacturing units of Government Departments / Undertakings.
 - iv) Registered SSI/MSME Units located in Government of Tamilnadu.
 - v) Other Manufacturers and authorized sole selling agents of Manufacturers.
 - vi) Authorised distributors of manufacturers
 - vii) Other supplier
- 3.2 Preference in the form of positive weightage will be given, while evaluating the bid in order of classification from 3.1 (i) to 3.1 (vi) as furnished in Para 3.1 above, with classification 3.1 (i) getting the top priority and classification 3.1 (vi) getting the least priority.
- 3.3 Documentary evidence to establish the classification of the bidder shall be furnished as part of its bid.
- 3.4 A Bidder will be classified as O.E. Manufacturer, only if the bidder furnishes evidence in the form of
- i) a certificate to that effect, issued by the Vehicle Manufacturer, certifying that the bidder is currently supplying to them, those items which are included in this bid.
 - ii) a Photostat copy of the current supply order and the quality test report issued by the Vehicle Manufacturer.
- 3.5 A Bidder will be classified as DGS & D Rate contract holders, only if
- i) the bidder furnished Photostat copy of
 - a) The award of Rate Contract
 - b) Terms and Conditions of the Rate Contract
 - c) Validity period of the Rate Contract and
 - d) Specifications, test procedures and penalty conditions of the Rate Contract.

- ii) The bidder shall furnish an Undertaking, along with the bid itself, to the effect that the, bidder shall agree to supply the items as per the terms and conditions, covered under the Rate Contract and preferred by MTC in addition, to the terms and conditions of this bid documents.
- 3.6 A Bidder will be classified as Registered SSI/MSME Unit in Tamilnadu, only if furnished clear and legible the bidder Photostat copy of the registration certificate issued by Govt. of Tamilnadu, registering the bidder as SSI/MSME Unit for manufacturing the items covered in this bid.

i) To reject the supply made

and or ii) To terminate the contract

and or iii) To procure such contractual quantities of contract items delayed from other sources and claim

a) Additional expenditure incurred by way of additional payment towards price, taxes/ levies /Transportation cost/ other cost plus

b) 10% overheads towards penalty and administrative charges.

and or v) To accept when the same price, Terms and conditions of contract, the contract item belatedly supplied or with inferior specification or different dimension, which will not be of detrimental nature for the functioning and performance of the contract items, and to claim a penalty amount equal to 10% of the Contract price.

2. TRANSPORTATION AND DELIVERY OF THE ITEM

i) The contract hereby agrees to supply and deliver the goods on FOR/Ex works basis furnished in Annexure-**II**

ii) All packing charges will be borne by the contractors.
